DOMINANT ROLE IN THE IOWA ECONOMY

- Advanced manufacturing is the largest industry sector in lowa, contributing nearly \$34 billion to the state's economy (Bureau of Economic Analysis, 2022)
- Advanced manufacturing represents 19% of lowa's GDP (Bureau of Economic Analysis, 2022)
- Approximately 4,300 manufacturers employ nearly 224,000 lowans (Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2022)
- lowa has 11 times the concentration of agricultural and construction equipment manufacturing employees compared to the rest of the U.S. (Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2022)
- lowa's agricultural and construction equipment manufacturers have over 23,000 employees with sales of nearly \$15 billion (U.S. Census Bureau, 2021 and Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2022)


