#### **COMPLIANCE - TCC RECOMMENDATION**

SAFI-Tech, Inc.: Ames – Request to Amend Contract Terms

MOTION: Jennifer Steffensmeier moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board approve the recommendation of the TCC to deny the request to modify the terms of the royalty repayment and instead require SAFI-TECH to pay IEDA \$25,000 upon sale of its assets and 90% of the royalties received until the balance is repaid, seconded by Tom Townsend. Motion carried unanimously.

WatchPoint Data, Inc.: Cedar Rapids - Request to Amend Contract Terms

**MOTION:** Tom Townsend moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board approve the recommendation of the TCC to approve the request to defer payments through December 2023, provided that the business is required to repay the Ioan in full upon closing on the sale of the business, seconded by Jennifer Steffensmeier. Motion carried unanimously.
