Innovas Technologies, LLC: Coralville - Request to Amend Contract Terms

<u>MOTION</u>: Doug Boone moved, seconded by Lisa Shimkat, that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation of the TCC to approve the request for a 12-month deferral of the balloon payment, provided that the Company makes a \$15,000 payment in November 2023 to be applied to the balance of the Ioan and then continue to make monthly payments of \$965.61 until the balloon payment is due in November 2024. Accelerated Ag dba Power Pollen: Ankeny - Request to Amend Contract Terms

<u>MOTION</u>: Lisa Shimkat moved that the lowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation of the TCC to approve the Company's request to delay the balloon payment for 24 months and instead continue to make monthly payments of \$2,896.82, seconded by Emily Schmitt. <u>MOTION</u>: Doug Boone moved that the Iowa Economic Development Authority Board accept the recommendation to approve the extension of the Project Completion Date by six months for the two Manufacturing 4.0 Technology Investment Awards to Tecton Industries, Inc. and to approve the request to extend the Project Completion Date by twelve months for the two Manufacturing 4.0 Technology Investment Awards to W.S. Darley & Co/dba Ohler Pump, seconded by Melissa Ballard. Motion carried unanimously.

AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO 28E AGREEMENT WITH IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (DNR) AND IOWA DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES (DAS)

Conservation Education Center (CEC) Buildings at Springbrook State Park

<u>MOTION</u>: Megan McKay moved, seconded by Emily Schmitt, to authorize the IEDA to enter into a 28E Agreement with the DNR and DAS that will ensure the proper maintenance of Springbrook State Park, define mitigation efforts to resolve the adverse effect from demolishing historical sites, and provide for DNR consultation with SHPO regarding the Trapper's Bay State Park Civilian Conservation Corps Shelter restoration project as mitigation. Motion carried unanimously.

Cloverwood 4H Camp

MOTION: Emily Schmitt moved, seconded by Megan McKay, to authorize the IEDA to enter into a 28E Agreement with the DNR and DAS that will ensure the proper development of the Cloverwood 4H Camp by defining mitigation efforts to resolve the adverse effect from demolishing the historical site and providing that DNR will consult with SHPO as DNR designs and constructs a display at the entrance of the Cloverwood parking lot with information on the history and use of the historical site. Motion carried unanimously.

<u>MOTION</u>: Melissa Ballard moved to authorize IEDA to enter into contracts with the National Main Street Center for \$250,000 and with R3 Uniq, Inc./Quadyster for \$130,000, seconded by Lisa Shimkat. Motion carried unanimously.
